  - Mentioned :Indy Food Fund: funds grass roots initiative
- c. Discussion and Activity: Creating Workgroups for Next Steps
  - i. Need for new working groups and committees. Will become permanent after 90-day period. People can join multiple committees. Amount per committee is flexible & based on what is needed. Coalition needs to identify strengths, what to learn, what to improve. Team Lead will be identified for each Committee to act as connector to other committee and to speak to the larger Coalition & other Committee Leads about updates, progress, needs (etc.) One member per committee can be a voting member; membership status.

- 4. Ideas/Vision for Next Steps:
  - a. Seed money can be leveraged to invest in tools and necessities
  - b. Connecting with funding opportunities and programs we can collaborate with leads to opportunities to merge priorities with and share information with Budget committee

- c. Outreach Committee offer opportunities for finding funding and support for small farmers and smaller businesses (this is especially beneficial to people in the
- d. Media Committee might be better used as a sub-team of the Outreach team and a separate committee can be set up for Tech.
- e. Potential Tech Commitee would manage website development, file sharing, managing digital records and information.
- f. Natalie's experience with a person asking for food inspired her to address the urgency of hunger and the need for Direct Service
- g. Direct Service offers a chance to "remember why we do this."
- h. Tawanda's thoughts: There is a scarcity of volunteers and a scarcity of equitable distribution. There is a need for more people to be aware of the need and where labor and capacity is needed.
- i. Membership Committee: A pre-existing group of designated members focused on the application process to recruit Coalition members

- j. Reach out to all the people who came to previous meetings and use these connections to then reach out to their organizations to connect with more people
- k. Focus on Voter Membership Applications and then preliminary review to identify who is qualified to join the currently 21-person team

- m. Focus on regulating and managing relations between members within Comittees
- n. Voting Members Application is primary and Executive Member is secondary
- o. Membership+Outreach Committees can identify ways to share information in an accessible way
- p. Question: What is the timeline to to reach out to Katheryne Boyles to ask for contact lists/ "beat list"
- q. Boyles offers to push stories on the Coalition's behalf to the "beat list"
- r. Tech: Website management, Digital Visualization, Social Media Management, and File Management, Administrative Details
  - a. Kiara: File Security, Social Media Management, Administrative Tasks/Organization
  - b. Jasper: Focus on Social media graphics and graphic design, Visuals
